Umoya Energy Wind Farm has announced funding as well as business mentoring for Theewatersvlei Boerdery. The local farm incorporates livestock and grain crops such as wheat, oats and lipien. The wheat produced on the farm is sold commercially, which means that the funding for machinery will impact directly on the farms production and turnover.

COMPLETED PHASE 2 HOMES RECEIVE NON-ELECTRIC SLOW COOKERS

We are pleased to announce that all homes that have been completed during the second phase of the Hopefield Home Improvement Project, will receive non-electric slow cookers, called Wonderbag's.

By the end of December 2018, we were able to complete plumbing upgrades in 137 houses, electrical upgrades in 236 houses and we were able to install ceilings in 215 houses.
