WEST COAST SCHOOLS EMBARK ON A LEADERSHIP JOURNEY

Three high schools on the West Coast are embarking on an exciting new leadership journey through the Columba Programme. Weston Secondary, Louville High, and New Vredenburg High School have been selected to participate in this empowering initiative.

The Columba Programme is set to kick off with five-day intensive leadership residential academies, taking place in July and August 2023. These academies aim to strengthen schools by focusing on improved discipline, enhanced school completion rates, and actively building the 21st-century skills and capabilities that the youth need to succeed in an ever-evolving world.

Moreover, the programme also fosters the adoption of essential values and improves the transition of young learners from school to tertiary education.



MY MATHS BUDDY PROGRAMME EMPOWERS LEARNERS

Teachers and learners at Steynville Secondary School, in Piketberg, are benefitting from a My Maths Buddy Effective Teaching programme, which commenced in April 2023.

Benefitting seven Maths teachers and 335 learners, the aim of the programme is to improve the quality of math teaching and learning in schools, promote a deeper understanding and appreciation of math among learners, enhance their problem-solving and critical thinking skills, and empower teachers with effective teaching strategies and resources.

As part of the programme, each learner received a My Maths Buddy learner kit, which included a dictionary, two insert cards, and a terminology workbook.

"This programme has made Mathematics a lot easier for me to understand. The dictionary really helped in giving me the knowledge and confidence I needed to excel in Maths," said one Grade 10 learner.

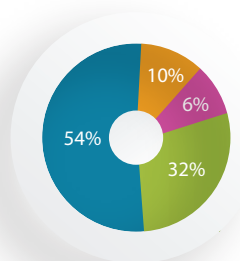
