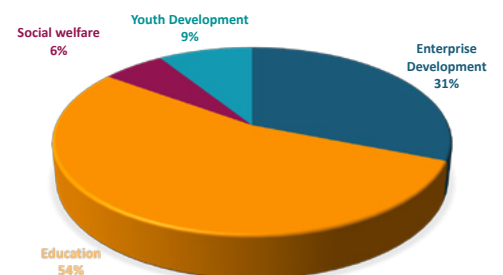


CELEBRATING 100 WOMEN OF STRENGTH
